Manufacturing of Disposable Medical Materials

This includes absorbent cotton fabrics, bandages, gauzes, dressings, medical adhesive tapes, syringes, tongue depressors, and disposable surgical products such as catherters, suturing materials, and disposable clothing: gowns, face masks, caps, sheets, scrub tops, and shoes.

Manufacturing of Non-Electric Equipment for Medical, Dental, and Laboratory Use

Surgical, dental, and orthopedic equipment (crutches, belts, corsets, orthopedic shoes); dental materials, false teeth, dental plates, mass produced and custom dental parts.

Manufacturing of Non-Woven (Compressed) Fabrics

Sanitary and surgical fabrics such as felts, interlinings, and absorbent cloths.
